General course structure at the advanced (master) level at the Department of Economics, Lund University

All courses at the advanced level begin with the course code NEKNxx or NEKPxx, where “xx” is a specific number for each course. The scope of each course is 7.5 ECTS credits, and all courses are part-time courses (but for the essay which is a full-time course of 15 ECTS). Thus, for full-time studies one takes four courses (30 ECTS) each term; two courses during the first part of the term, and another two during the second part. It is highly recommended that a student follows a recommended profile in Economics. The essay is completed during the second part of the spring term. A graphical presentation of the structure is provided below.
