### **About conditional admission**

If you have a conditional admission, which in that case is indicated on your Letter of Admission (or Notification of Selection Results) available via “your pages” on Studera.nu, you have to pay special attention to the below (which you should already be familiar with). The most common reason for a conditional admission is that you did not have a completed Bachelor degree at the time for the application, but that you will be awarded your degree before the programme commences. The related message on “your pages” or on your Letter of Admissions is typically something like:

*Your general eligibility is conditional: In order to begin your studies you must show that you fulfill the general requirement of a completed academic degree comprising of at least 180 ECTS credits or equivalent. The requirement must be fulfilled and the appropriate credentials presented to the institution when the programme/course starts at the latest.*

Thus, in order to commence the programme you have been admitted to, you must present your degree documents. All documents should be in the original language, and in officially certified translations into Swedish, English, French or German, if the original documents are in a language other than the Scandinavian languages.

The documents should be presented to the Master Programme Coordinator at the Department of Economics (Dr Mårten Wallethe: [master@nek.lu.se](mailto:master@nek.lu.se)), who will present them to the Degree Office at Lund University for evaluation, and then return them to you. ***Please note. Bring all documents that you have received and which are related to your degree.***

If you fail to present any of the above documents, you will not be allowed to commence the programme.
